Arrest counts provide a measure of law enforcement's response to crime. The arrest practices for certain conduct like drunkenness, disorderly conduct, vagrancy, and related violations may differ among agencies. However, the practices for more serious conduct like robbery, burglary, and other serious crime are more likely to be uniform across all jurisdictions. Reporting procedures require that an arrest be counted on each separate occasion a person is taken into custody or cited. Arrests include the following three categories:

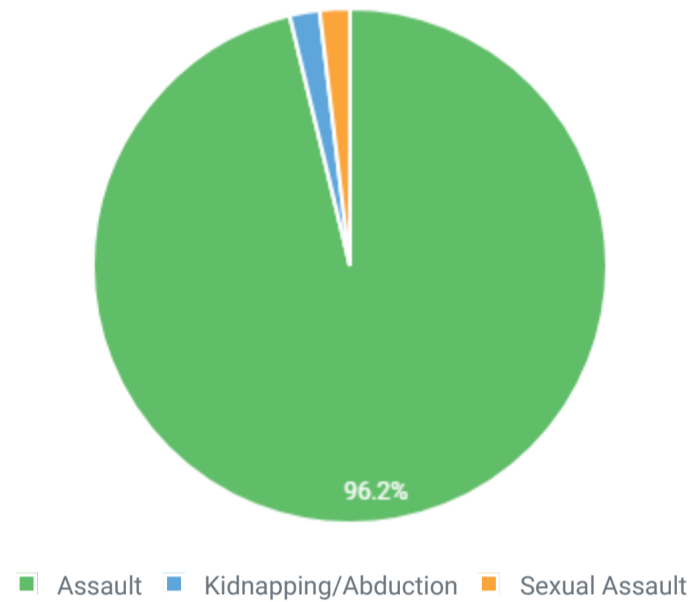
a) O=On-View Arrest (apprehension without a warrant or previous incident report)

b) S= Summoned/Cited (not taken into custody)

c) T=Taken into Custody

Annual arrest figures do not measure the number of individuals arrested, since one person may be arrested several times during the year for the same crime or different crimes. One person can also be arrested for multiple crimes at the same time, and this is only counted as a single arrest.

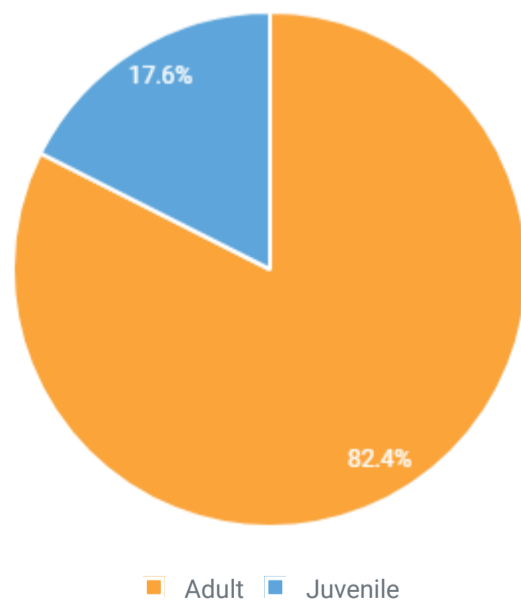

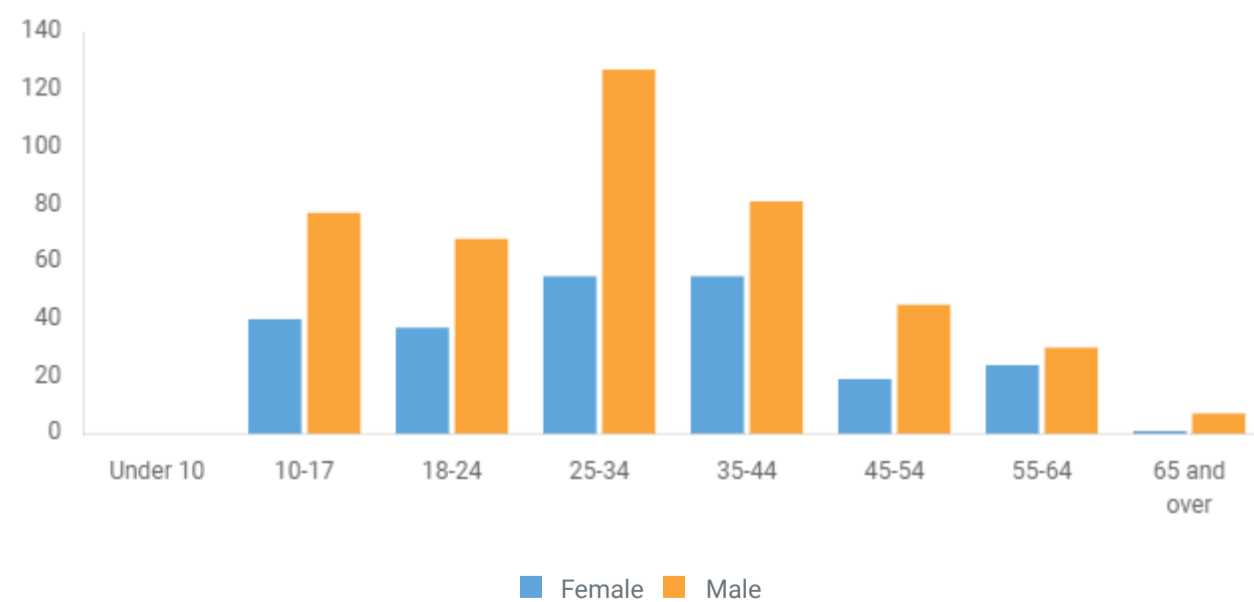
